




Participants will learn how to design and lead workshops that promote understanding, tolerance, and respect among different cultural and social groups.


They will gain the skills to address conflicts and prejudices that arise between (young) people from diverse backgrounds.

Through practical exercises, participants will explore methods for initiating dialogue, overcoming stereotypes, and creating safe spaces for open discussions.









What will participants gain?

The training will provide youth workers and volunteers with the tools to run workshops in schools and community centers that encourage intercultural dialogue.

They will be equipped to handle sensitive issues and conflicts in a way that fosters cooperation and mutual respect.

Participants will also gain a understanding of the challenges faced by minority groups and learn how to create inclusive, supportive environments for young people from diverse backgrounds.






Topic




TRAVEL SUGGESTIONS FOR **AIRPORTS**

Slovenia is a small country with only one airport located near Ljubljana (Ljubljana airport -Letališče Jožeta Pučnika Ljubljana). **Connections** that this airport offers are quite expensive and has bad connections, so usually we also travel from other airports. Of course there is a chance that you might be lucky.

We suggest you that you travel from your country to one of this airports:

- Vienna,
- Budapest,
- Zagreb,
- Trieste,
- Venice Marco Polo,
- Graz airport.









TRAVEL SUGGESTIONS FROM AIRPORTS TO SLOVENIA

When you arrive to the airport that was convenient from your country, we suggest you chose Flixbus or internaional train to travel to Slovenia.

In Slovenia we have Flixbus station in two cities:


- in Maribor (which is in the east of the country),
- in Ljubljana (which is in the center of Slovenia).

If you will be travelling with train - check if you have direct line to Velenje. If not - check if your train is going towards Celje, Maribor or Ljubljana.

We can help you choose which Flixbus station or which train is more convenient, due to the airport that you will be arriving.


When you arrive to Slovenia there are **two ways that you can arrive to Velenje**:

- bus Nomago (https://www.nomago.si/vozovnice/vozni-red) website is available also in English,
- train **Slovenske železnice** (https://potniski.sz.si/) website is available also in English.

Remember to keep all the receipts and invoices for the expenses during the travel. Without them we cannot reimburse the money.















Visa is an expense covered within the Erasmus+ budget. However, we will need proof of payment, such as an **invoice or receipt**.

We kindly ask you to check with the relevant authorities in your country about the application procedure. Based on our inquiry with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Slovenia, we must provide you a certified official invitation - a Letter of Guarantee.
